As a Center for Independent Living (CIL), CRI has four core services to provide: Information & Referral, Advocacy, Life Skills Training, and Peer Support. CIL's are to provide these services to people with disabilities of all ages. CRI is contracted with the University of Temple to run their Pennsylvania Initiative on Assistive Technology (PIAT) Program. As an Attendant Care Provider, CRI runs several state funded programs. These programs are for people with physical disabilities 18 years old and older. Programs include: MA Waiver, Act 150, OBRA Waiver, Independence Waiver, CommCare Waiver, Michael Dallas Waiver, PDA Waiver, Options, Private Pay Contracts, and AAA Contracts.
